We understand that sustainability strategies are integral to improving quality of life, including indoor air quality, utility costs, access to green space and sunlight, and durable and renewable materials. These not only enhance the

resident experience, but also contribute to a lower building footprint on a larger scale. We always design for long-life, low-energy buildings. We make sure to select durable systems and materials with long-term maintenance in mind, considering how buildings are occupied and maintained over time, and which systems will likely be upgraded in the future. We work closely with our contractor and MEP consultants to evaluate life cycle costs and building envelope performance and come up with the ideal flexible solutions to meet the project goals.

Resilient Neighborhoods

Schemata Workshop champions a holistic and comprehensive vision for neighborhood design. This vision elevates social and cultural issues to the same high level of importance and aspiration as environmental concerns. Modular/ Alternative Construction Methods

Schemata has been a leader in alternative construction techniques. We are one of only two firms who has used volumetric modular for affordable housing in western Washington. We have designed several projects for modular construction and have looked at cross laminated timber (CLT) for several projects. Schemata hopes the modular industry holds the key to the "Missing Middle" in home construction and can assist communities in creating housing swiftly to alleviate the current housing shortage crisis.
